Introduction

 Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) reporting is mandatory for all institutions participating in federal student financial aid programs under Title IV

Failure to comply with IPEDS reporting requirements may result in fines of up to \$35,000 per survey

Introduction (cont'd)

Changes to IPEDS follow a set review and approval process

When feasible, NCES includes a "preview year" before changes are mandatory

Preview year is optional

 - Percentage of total revenue from federal grants

Changes for 2015-16

Outcome Measures (OM) Winter Collection 2015-16

Rationale for change:

- Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 required DoE to assist 2-year degreegranting institutions in meeting graduation rate disclosure requirement
- Committee on Measures of Student Success recommended
 - Broaden the coverage of student graduation data
 - Improve collection of student progression and completion data
 - Improve technical guidance to institutions
 - Encourage institutions to disclose comparable data on employment outcomes

Outcome Measures (OM) Winter Collection 2015-16

Rationale for change (cont'd):

- Two TRPs reviewed feasibility of collecting outcome information and recommended new component
- OM component designed to provide consumers, policymakers, and researchers
 - Context for graduation rates (as defined by Student Right to Know)
 - Alternative to graduation rates

Outcome Measures (OM) Winter Collection 2015-16

- Outcomes data, as determined by TRP
 - Students, by cohort, who
 - Received award
 - Did not receive award, still enrolled at reporting institution
 - Did not receive award, subsequently enrolled at another institution
 - Did not receive award, subsequent enrollment status unknown
