
### The Need for Outsourcing

- The goal for the small IR office is to get someone to do your work for you

## Texas Higher Education Data—The New Kinko's

- In like manner, www.txhighereddata.org offers pre-built data resources with your school data that can drastically reduce your workload—if you play your cards right


#### Information Overload

- One criticism, might be that the reports are overly complex and confusing to novice users
- To overcome this anxiety, learn to glean
  - to gather by acquisition, scrape together

Because of interest from our Board of Trustees, I created two graphs for time-to-degree: semester credit hour and years-to-degree


#### Temple College-Time to Degree


## How to Get Started with Your Outsourcing

- Know all of the THECB Data reports and what they contain
  - You will quickly determine the ones that are useful and which are not
  - Determine what small data snapshots you can retrieve for communicating with broad stakeholders
  - Look beyond the report to individual data points that might be useful to you
- Know the interactive systems and how to use them, e.g.
  - Accountability System, especially the interactive system
  - Profile Reports (PREP)
  - Texas CREWS


## Temple College Transfers to Texas Public Universities Fall 2014

### **Technical Program Resources**

- Exit Cohort Report
  - 42 pages of information most people don't care about
  - About 3 pages of information that Deans and Department Chairs care a lot about—mean and median wages
- Automated Student and Adult Learner Followup Report
  - Good for reporting success rates for technical programs

## Goal—Finding the Best Information in the Most Efficient Manner

- Data may be found in multiple areas:
  - Almanac comparison sheets, ASALF, The Accountability Systems Interactive access to data, Profile Reports (PREP)
- Similar information may appear on different reports using different methodologies
  - Know the methodology
  - Know what your audience will expect or understand
- As far as I can tell, some data is only reported one place




