- Substantive Change: Audit, audit, audit
- Review your historical records and compare to previous audit
- Prepare an inventory focused on substantive changes
- Create a good repository for both Institutional and SACSCOC correspondence
- Multiple points of review

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A LIAISON?

- Establish good line of internal and external communication
- Maintain a good line of communication with your SACSCOC StaffVP
- Make sure you are communicating with all your internal stakeholders
- Monitor curriculum actions

KNOW THE STANDARDS

- Reporting deadlines
- Annual updates
- Attend meetings, webinars, training
- Periodically review the SACSCOC webpage for changes and updates
