- IE consists of 8 staff, 1 student worker, 1 vacancy
 - staffing resources are shared between P&A and IR
- 3 IE staff are partially dedicated to the data warehouse project

Data Warehouse Timeline

2013	> Dean of Human Sciences and Humanities (HSH) and the Associate VP of Academic Affairs request program level data that is accessible.					
2013-2014	 First attempt to creating a data warehouse to generate program review data. MS SQL infrastructure is implemented and di the reports are produced. 					
2014-2015	> High turnover in IR.					
2015	> New IR team reviews previous work and meets with HSH Dean and HSH Director of Operations to redefine reporting requirements.					
	> IR begins research and development using new methodologies and current technical infrastructure. IR also decides to provide these reports the other colleges.					
	> IR meets with all deans to inform them of the development of program level reports and asks for input.					
2016-2017	> New drafts of the Program Review Reports are developed and distributed via share drives for review.					
	> Approved Reports are produced every term and distributed via share drives					
2017	> Fall term, OIE Secure Data Portal goes live with Program Review Reports that are now accessible by faculty and staff.					
2018	> New UHCL President and Executive Director of Information Resources reach out to IE to lead the Data Warehouse Initiative with					
	support of University Computing and Telecommunications (UCT) department.					
	> Development of the Data Warehouse Steering Committee and the Data Warehouse Technical Work Group					
	> IR met with all colleges individually and asked for buy-in for this initiative.					
2018-2019	> Hold monthly meetings to provide updates on progress, address additional data needs, and discuss data definitions and terms					
	> Currently testing Power BI capabilities and user level security					
	> Working on Data Dictionary					
	> Formation of the Data Analysis Governance group




