Methodology (Processing the Raw Data)

- \cdot How to clean the fields:
 - · Check Institution names
 - · Create Statewide row
 - · Convert percentages into decimals
 - · Clear cells with "N/A" and "See Campus"
 - · Unmerge any merged cells
- 2020 Data:
 - · Reports on District-Wide data but does not break down College/Campus-level
 - No longer included columns for: Year, Peer Group Size, Full-time and Part-time 4-Year Graduation rates, Student-Faculty ratio, Developmental Education and Non-Developmental Education Graduation rates





Development of Dashboard

- Upload file into Power BI
- · Create individual pages for each metric of interest
- · Add filters and tooltips
- · Create fact sheet
- · Publish





Development of Dashboard Continued

- Create Conditional Columns:
 - College specific indicators (Graduation Rate, Transfer Rate, Student Debt, etc.) create a Visualization to show our College as the comparison group
 - · Add Cohort Years

Filters

- There are many different Visualization options for presenting data.
- Filters allow users to disaggregate by multiple indicators.
- Current filters include: Institution,
 Peer Group size, and Almanac
 Year







Tooltips

- By clicking on a specific Institution, a highlighted bar will appear to allow a comparison of multiple sets of data at once.
- Tooltips are convenient for users to view their Institution's data in comparison to another, while seeing the average of all 2-Year Public Institutions.







Multiple Sheets

- Having many sheets allow for you to organize each into specific categories.
- By hovering over the sheet numbers at the bottom, this screen will appear to show all of the titles of each sheet.





Creating a Fact Sheet

- Definitions are derived directly from the THECB reports.
- This is included at the bottom of each page to allow for easy access to the user.

Definitions, Data Years, and THECB Data Sources

Graduation Rates:

<u>Public two-year college 3-,4-, and 6-year rates</u>: The percentage of first-time, credentialseeking undergraduates who graduate within 3, 4, or 6 academic years for two groups: those students who enrolled in their first fall as full-time students (taking 12 or more semester credit hours [SCH]) and those who enrolled part-time (taking fewer than 12 SCH). Both degrees and certificates are included.

Developmental Education:

<u>Developmental education/non-developmental education rates</u>: Percentage of first time, full-time, credential-seeking undergraduates who graduated after three academic years by whether they met or did not meet state readiness standards in one or more areas under the Texas Success Initiative (TSI).</u>
