- National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) are working together to create a broader picture of the state's enrollment and retention patterns
- THECB has retained Student Tracker premium services for all Texas public institutions for the next two years in a move to increasingly provide Texas institutions with useful and actionable information about the student educational pipeline
  - Several private institutions have also joined in












